### YOUNG

Young Europeans aged 18 to 26 are eligible to take part.



### COMPREHENSIVE

The routes each last two weeks. You'll find the latest route dates on our website.



### DIVERSE

You can look forward to discovering new things, visiting exciting places, having interesting discussions and growing to meet new challenges.



### INTERNATIONAL

Because the language of communication is English, you should be able to express yourself in this language.



### PARTICIPATION FEE

We charge a participation fee of € 100 per person. You may also have to pay additional costs for travel to and from the route at the beginning and end, since we only pay a travel allowance to cover these costs.



### NO ADDED COSTS

All costs for your accommodation, meals, entrance fees and transport during the route, as well as any visa costs, are paid for by the project.



## FOLLOWING IN HISTORY'S FOOTSTEPS

### BLUE ROUTE



The Blue Route starts in St. Petersburg and goes on to Riga via the night train. From there, the journey continues through the Baltic states to Gdańsk. The route ends on the island of Usedom.

### GREEN ROUTE



The Green Route goes from Weimar to Prague and on to Munich and Überlingen, and then to the Hartmannswillerkopf hill in the Alsace region. The journey continues to Strasbourg and Verdun, and ends in Niederbronn-les-Bains.

### YELLOW ROUTE



The Yellow Route begins in Sarajevo and then takes the group to Belgrade via Srebrenica. From there, the journey continues to Kragujevac, Skopje and via Prilep to Thessaloniki.
